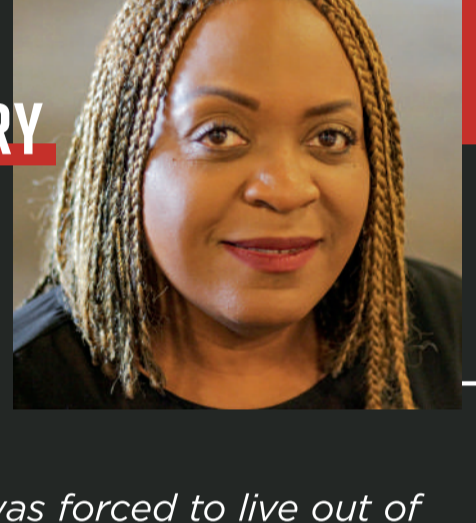

MIRACLE CITY PROGRESS

Construction on the Miracle City campus continues to progress forward, and we anticipate the first building (Empowerment Center) to be completed by the end of January 2022. While the construction process has had its twists and turns that we could have never expected, we are learning to lean into God more and trust His timing. We are beyond thrilled to see light at the end of the tunnel and can't wait to walk each and every one of you around the campus in the near future.

- Complete the **EMPOWERMENT CENTER** Building by January 2022. It Will Become the New Home of CHOP.
- Scheduled to Begin Construction on the **DAY CENTER** Building in Mid-2022.
- Scheduled to Start Building the First **TRANSITION HOME** by the End of 2022.
- Between Donations and Grants, We Have Raised **\$2.6M** for Miracle City to Date.
- The **DAY CENTER** will be the largest building on Miracle City's campus. It will have the capacity to serve over 300 people per day with food, clothing, hygiene items, spiritual guidance and more.
- The **TRANSITION HOME** will have the capacity to house 16 men at one time, providing many a safe, stable home for the first time in a long time.
